

15 Mile Interceptor Collapse Update

Feb. 15, 2017

What's new:

- Additional pumps are being installed along the long-term bypass of the 15 Mile Sewer Collapse. These pumps should be installed this week.
- Requests for bids for the repair of the collapsed sewer interceptor were issued on Friday, Feb. 10. Bids are due back in to the Public Works Office on March 3.
- 15 Mile Road is now completely open for traffic west of Hayes Road.
- On or about Feb. 28, Hayes Road, north of 15 Mile Road, will be closed for the duration of the repair work – into late 2017.

Ongoing:

- Work continues from both the east and the west on the long-term bypass pipes that will carry all sewage flow around the collapsed interceptor. That work should be wrapped up by the first week of March.
