**PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING FLOODING CLAIMS**

Any person who experiences an overflow or backup of a sewage disposal system or storm water system must file a written claim within 45 days after the overflow or backup was discovered or in the exercise of reasonable diligence should have been discovered. Notice should be mailed or delivered to Macomb County Public Works Commissioner Candice S. Miller, 21777 Dunham Road, Clinton Township, MI 48036. Under state law, failure to provide the required notice will prevent recovery or damages. Immediately upon discovery of an overflow or backup, call (877) 679-4337, a toll free, 24-hour, flood and water pollution telephone hotline provided by the Macomb County Public Works Commissioner.
